Pupil Premium Funding

Pupil premium is extra funding given to the school to support pupils of all abilities. Our school cam receive valuable funding which can be used to support all the children in their education

Pupil premium is paid for pupils that are eligible for <u>free school meals</u>, or have been eligible for free school meals in the last 6 years

The funding is currently:

- £935 for a secondary age pupil
- £1,320 for a primary age pupil

We would like to encourage all families who fit the criteria to apply for Pupil Premium Funding
