#### **School Reopening**

Further to the announcement on Sunday, we are exploring how best to prepare for a phased re opening of the school. A survey is being sent out to parents of children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 to help up with this planning. If you have children in these year groups, please look out for the survey and complete it as soon as possible. Guidance is being updated regularly and we will ensure parents are informed as decisions are made.

### **Changing Circumstances**

The current lockdown has impacted on many sectors and we recognise that there may have been financial impact on many of our families. Please do check the gov.uk website for information about financial support, including universal credits. You may also be eligible for free school meals, which at the moment are being supported through a voucher scheme. Class Zoom Meet Ups—We so enjoyed the class zoom sessions last week and are setting up sessions for next week. We will ensure that there are at least two staff members in each session, will use the waiting room facility and will stop the session immediately if there are any concerns. We ask that an appropriate adult is in the room when children are using zoom.


