We are delighted to update you on the outdoor learning the children will be accessing at school.

Explorers Class will be having Beach School each Tuesday afternoon. Please make sure your child has wellies, a waterproof, an extra pair of socks and appropriate headgear.

Pathfinders Class have Outdoor Learning on a Wednesday afternoon for 5 weeks. Please make sure your child has wellies, a waterproof coat and a change of clothes if possible.
